Welcome to March. Energy levels of our students have risen with the arrival of the warm weather.

With the beginning of Term 3, at the start of February, we were able to analyze Term 2 Data. We are very proud of our students and the success they had in Term 2. There was an improvement from our Term 1 Data. Remember that we use the following Green/Yellow/Red criteria from each term to measure success and to help organize learning supports and plans for students who fall in the yellow and red categories. Green - Passing all cores with a mark of 60% or more, Yellow - At risk - Marks are between 50 and 59% in one or more cores and Red - Failing one or more cores.

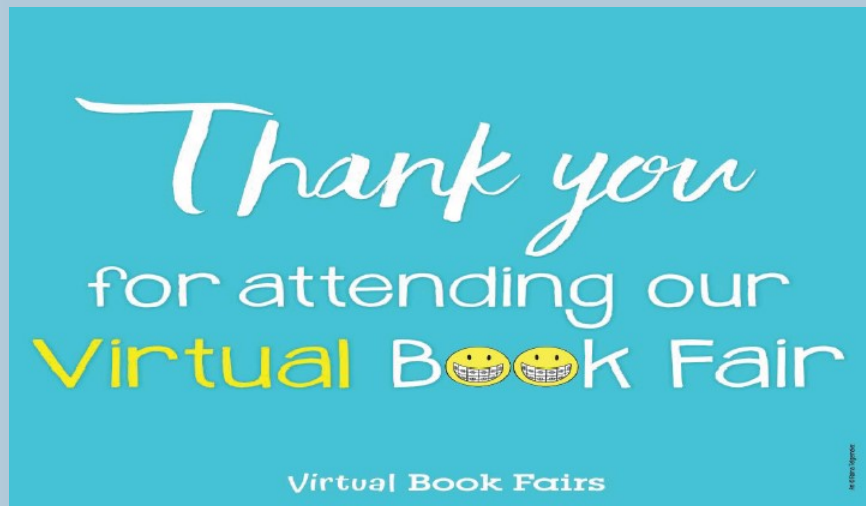
