This activity organized by the 8-1, 2 team is a wonderful reminder to bring attention to examples of positive behaviour and gratitude each day.

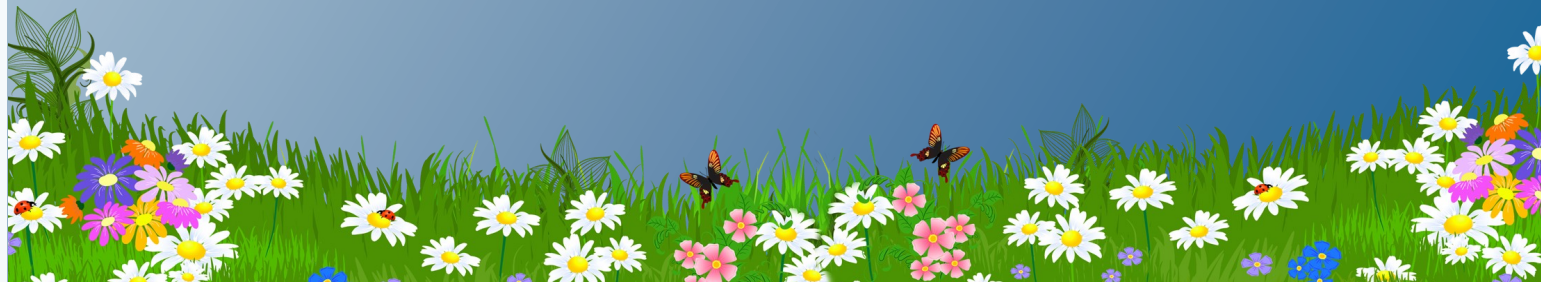

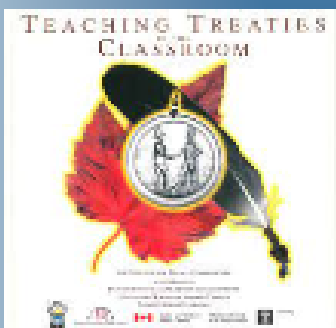


NEW BOOKS EVERYWHERE!
