# **ACHIEVEMENT EVENT**

With the inability to host our annual June Achievement Night, due to COVID-19 guidelines, the Bishop Lloyd staff has organized an Achievement Day & Awards Celebration for Wednesday, June 9th. The event will be held during the school day to recap the school year, celebrate student achievements and recognize our grade 9 students as they transition from middle school to high school. The events will be recorded with the links being shared with students and families over the weeks of June 14th to 18th. Sharing as a link and not a live presentation will allow families to view the virtual presentations at a time that best fits their family's schedule.

On **Wednesday June 9th**, we will have a "formal dress up day" where all students in the school are invited to wear business casual clothes for our events throughout the day.

In the morning from 9am-10am we will have our school-wide Awards Ceremony, where our administrators will announce award winners via Google Meets with students in their classrooms. Award winners will be celebrated in their classrooms and given any certificates or medals that come with their award. After the ceremony, award winners will get their picture taken with their plaque. Award winners and their pictures will be posted online for parents to view and save.

At 12pm our grade 9 celebration will begin. Students will stay in their homerooms from 12pm to 1pm where they will receive lunch provided by BLMS. During their lunch, they will view speeches from classmates and from our principal, as well as their "Grade 7 to Grade 9 Journey through BLMS" slideshow. They will receive a gift from our school at this time as well. Next, from 1pm to 2pm, all grade 9 students will go outside to our school grounds, where there will be music, treats, and numerous creative backdrops for students to take photos with. We will also take class photos at this time. Photos, speeches, and slideshows will be available online for parents to view after the event.



All vegetables grown will be donated to local charities to provide healthy vegetables to families in need and to help fight food scarcity.




# STEM PROJECTS - GR 7-1, 7-2

Libby S. and Tanishka V. are students in Mrs. Tremmel and Miss. Furman's grade 7 team. The girls showed a thorough understanding of the grade 7 math and english concepts. As a result, they fast tracked through the grade 7 curriculum and spent extra time working on some STEM projects (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math).

BLMS STEMspirations was one of their projects which focused on interviewing Women in STEM careers. They interviewed two women. One was a chemical engineer and owner of a vertical hydroponic greenhouse. The other was a Geology student who earned her degree at the U of A and is going to UBC in the fall to earn her master's degree. The girls prepared appropriate questions and then created and edited videos of the interviews. They also ran a social media campaign on Instagram & Twitter advertising the interviews and other STEM information.

Another project they worked on was the BLMS 3D Design Company. The girls designed and started a company in which they offered custom design and print 3D objects. The items were made using an online program called Tinkercad. The cost of the items were dependent on the amount of filament used as well as the time required to print. To track orders, the girls created and used a spreadsheet. Order forms were offered to Rendell Park's grade 5 and 6 classes. The demand for 3-D printed items was an overwhelming success!

To date, a total of \$205 has been raised. All proceeds will be donated to the Lloydminster SPCA.
