SCHOOL FEES

Bishop Lloyd is in the process of implementing Activity Right, an online payment program that will be operational by the end of October. Invitations to set up an account will be sent out prior to October 29.

Each school year, BLMS staff discuss a PRIDE focus for the school year, in which we work on and celebrate different qualities to develop in our students. This year, we are going to focus on the P in PRIDE. P stands for Positive. 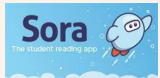
LANCER LIBRARY

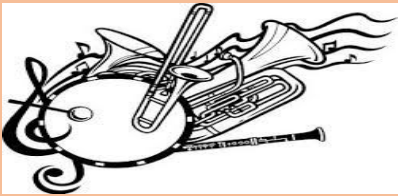
