A special thank you to all students, staff and families for their commitment to Term 1 at Bishop Lloyd. Term 1 ends on November 5th and Term 2 will start on Monday, November 15th when we return from the November Break. Staff will be submitting Term 1 marks by November 5th. For students and parents connected to Edsby, you should be able to see an electronic copy of the Term 1 Report Card by Monday, November 15th. All students will receive a paper copy of their report card to bring home on November 16th.

At the end of each reporting period the admin team uses term data to analyze student success in core subjects for all grade level cohorts. We use the following Green/Yellow/Red criteria from each term to organize learning supports and plans for students who fall in the yellow and red categories. We want all of our students to be in the green.

Green - Passing all cores with a mark of 60% or more.

Yellow - At risk - Marks are between 50 and 59% in one or more cores.

Red - Failing one or more cores.

Student Led Conferences are scheduled for November 17th and 18th. Once again SLC will be virtual with a Google Meet link being shared through your child's LPSD email account. Teachers will be emailing out SLC invites to parents by November 5th to provide parents the opportunity to select a date and time for their child's conference.
