Funds that were raised from the coupons cards go directly to student learning and extra curricular experiences that may not have occurred with fundraising dollars. Thank you to our school community for contributing.





Bishop Lloyd has a free breakfast program that serves approximately 100 students daily.


Breakfast is available daily from 8:00 - 8:20 Monday through Friday in the Commons for any students who would like it.

Once students grab their breakfast, they need to head back to their desk in their homeroom to eat.




