Happy New Year! I hope families enjoyed the holiday break and are looking forward to 2022.

January is going to move very quickly with the Term 2 reporting period coming to a close on January 28th and report cards going live on Edsby by Wednesday, February 2nd. We will also be sending home a paper copy of the Term 2 Report Card. With the end of Term 2 students will see final marks assigned for some of their courses. 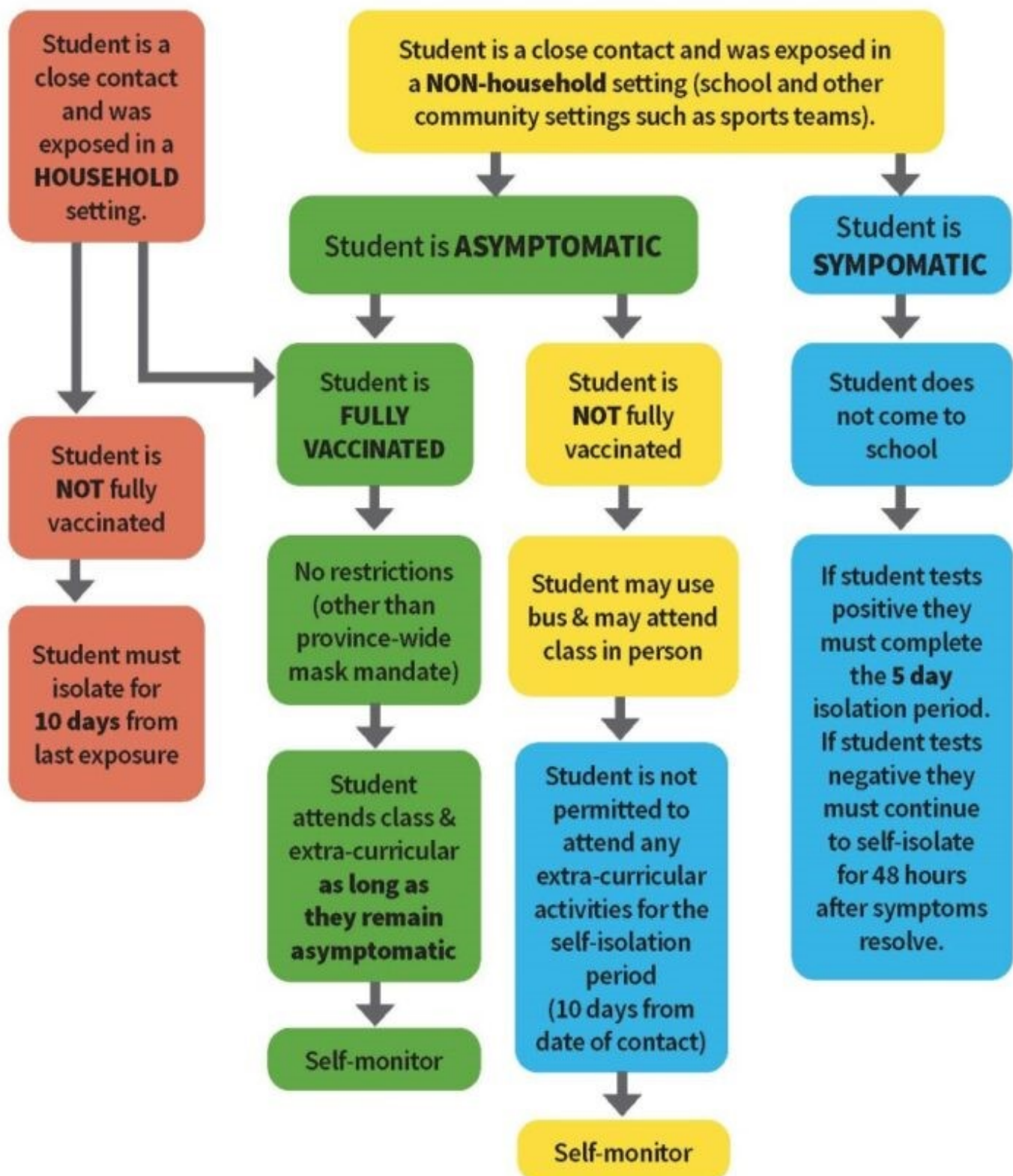
