Fundraising Coupon Cards

This year our school is selling coupon cards for local businesses in Lloydminster, to raise money at Bishop Lloyd Middle School. Our school goal is to have each student (410) sell one coupon card for \$20. From the sale of the coupon card, our school profits half of the amount. Therefore, if each student sells one card, our school will raise just over \$4000.

The funds raised go to support numerous activities, events, and educational opportunities for our students within the school year. On the coupon card, there are single use coupons, as well as a mini card that is reusable until October 31, 2022.

If purchasers access 2-3 of the coupons, the coupon card pays for itself. Remember the card is valid, along with every coupon on the card, until October 31, 2023.

If you would like to purchase a card, please send \$20 to the school with your child, or come to the school to purchase a card at the office.

Fundraising for Bishop Lloyd Middle School, is a way to strengthen community, participate and work together as a team, and to foster shared responsibility for providing opportunities for our students.

Incentives will be provided to students to get out and sell 1 card- to neighbors, family members, family friends, etc. As well, we will celebrate as a school, the milestones we reach along the way to our ultimate goal of 1 card sold per student at BLMS (410 cards).

Lancer Library

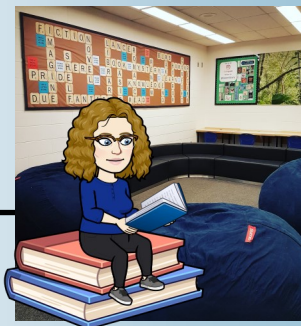
Welcome to another year in our Lancer Library!

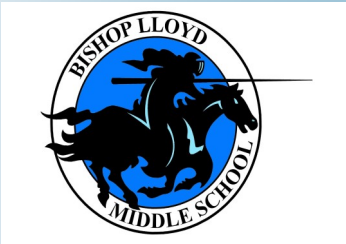


LANCER ATHLETICS

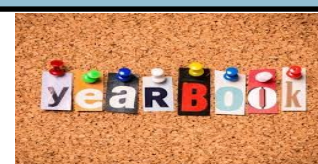

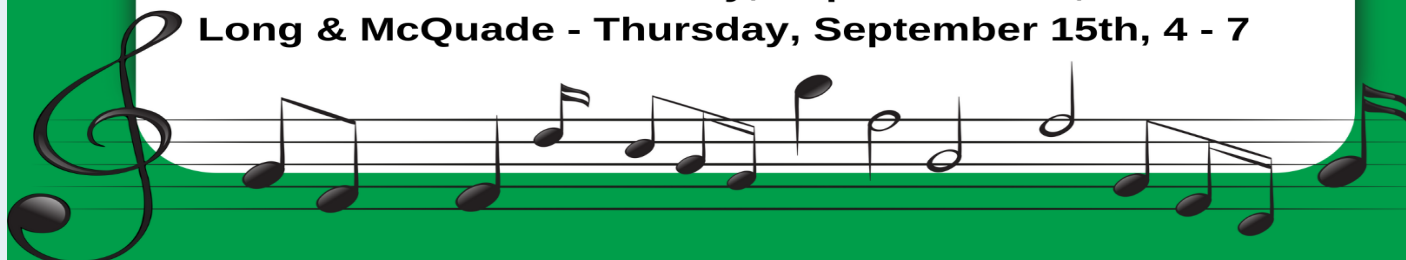
Instrument Rental Nights

CHILDREN OF RESIDENTIAL SCHOOLS ARE HONOURED ANNUALLY ON ORANGE SHIRT DAY. THE CAMPAIGN'S SLOGAN - EVERY CHILD MATTERS - LOOSELY TRANSLATES TO KAHKIYAW AWASISAK KIHCEYAKOSIWAK IN CREE, WHICH MEANS ALL CHILDREN ARE SACRED.

As part of First Nations culture, childhood is the foundation of our journey through life. Building a strong foundation is vital to the development of the person they will become. The translation of Children are Sacred, honours the Cree holistic value that everything in life is sacred.

Orange Shirt Day began to help spread awareness for children who attended residential schools. The orange shirt symbolizes these children having their identities stripped away. LPSD schools will be celebrating the culture and honouring the history through featuring displays that will include images and videos of the Orange Shirt Day Campaign and Residential Schools starting the week of September 26, 2022.

To reinforce that Every Child Matters, students are encouraged to wear orange on Friday, September 30, 2022. Students can choose to purchase an orange shirt from their local school.
