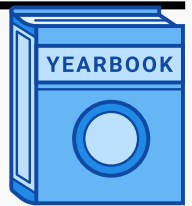


Registration Forms and Fees

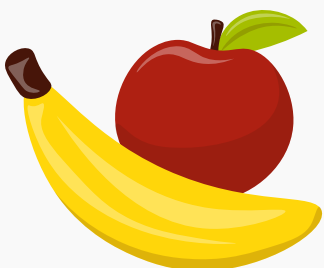

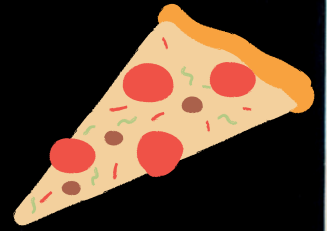

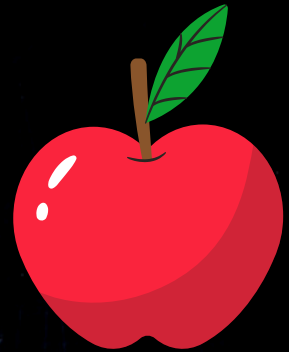
