Wishing all students, staff, and families a relaxing November Break!

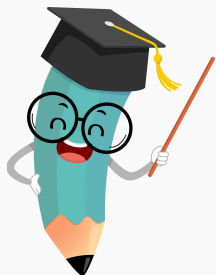
